

What should I do, if want to come to the dormitory of CTU from foreign countries

If I come from the country with a high or very high risk infection:

Step 1



First, I contact well in advance the head of the dormitory on e-mail: ubytovani@suz.cvut.cz

Step 2



I wait for acceptance of coming to the dormitory by the head of the dormitory and I fill the form on website: plf.uzis.cz

Step 3



Before the coming to the Czech Republic I have to have the NEGATIVE PCR test for COVID-19* (not older than 72 hours).

Step 4



After the arrive/arrival to the Czech Republic, I have to stay 6 days on the self-isolation*, during it it is impossible stay in my room in the dormitory. If I don't have any possibilities of accomodation, I can use the accomodation in block 12 on Strahov. The check-in is on the Central reception, Strahov Dormitory, block 1. Price is 147 CZK/per night.

Step 5



5th Day of the self-isolation I have to pass the PCR test for COVID-19* (at my own expence). If the test is negative, I will tell the information to the head of the dormitory and I should go to my room in the dormitory.

If I come from the country with a extreme risk infection:

Step 1



First, I contact well in advance the head of the dormitory on e-mail: ubytovani@suz.cvut.cz

Step 2



I wait for acceptance of coming to the dormitory by the head of the dormitory and I fill the form on website: plf.uzis.cz

Step 3



Before the coming to the Czech Republic I have to have the NEGATIVE PCR test for COVID-19* (not older than 72 hours) and confirmation of the reservation for next PCR test in Czech republic. This test I have to pass maximally 24 hours after the coming to the Czech republic.*

Step 4



After the arrive/arrival to the Czech Republic, I have to stay 11 days on the self-isolation*, during it it is impossible stay in my room in the dormitory. If I don't have any possibilities of accomodation, I can use the accomodation in block 8 on Strahov. The check-in is on the Central reception, Strahov Dormitory, block 1. Price is 147 CZK/per night.

Step 5



10th day of the self-isolation I have to pass the PCR test for COVID-19* (at my own expence). If the test is negative, I will tell the information to the head of the dormitory and I should go to my room in the dormitory.

Step 6



Next 14 days, I will use the respirator FFP2 throughout.


For entrance to the CTU dormitory from the country with other degree of risk the dormitories are guided by the following overviews:



Rules for entry and return to the Czech Republic (as of 23rd August 2021)

PART A

citizens of Czechia and foreign nationals with a residence permit issued by the Czech Republic
citizens of EU+ and foreign nationals with a long-term or permanent residence permit issued by EU+
it is possible to enter the country for any reason



Travellers from all countries have an obligation to fill in the Passenger Locator Form before the arrival.



There are several exceptions from the obligation to fill in the Passenger Locator Form or undergo testing. **All rules and exceptions can be found in the Ministry of Health Protective Measure.**



A list of countries with a low, medium and high risk of Covid-19 transmission and a list of countries with an extreme risk of Covid-19 transmission can be found here. **A country listed in neither list of countries is considered as a country with a very high risk of Covid-19 transmission.**



Groups of persons, who do not have the obligation to undergo testing and self-isolation after the arrival:


- persons who had Covid-19 in last 180 days (it is necessary to have an EU digital COVID certificate or a certificate issued by an authorized subject operating in a third country, for which was adopted an implementing act in accordance with the European Union regulation on EU digital COVID certificates)
- vaccinated persons - 14 days after the application of the last dose - according to these rules:
 - vaccinated in the EU+ - it is necessary to have an EU digital COVID certificate
 - vaccinated outside of the EU+ - it is necessary to have an EU digital COVID certificate or a written confirmation whose sample is published on the Ministry of Health website; **only vaccinations approved by EMA or products produced in compliance with the patent of the approved vaccinations are accepted**

Citizens and residents of Czechia can enter the country even in case of a positive test before arrival. Rules for transport with a positive test are described in the Ministry of Health Protective Measure.

Rules for entry and return to the Czech Republic (as of 23rd August 2021)

PART B

third-country nationals who do not have any residence permit issued by the Czech Republic or a long-term or permanent residence permit issued by other EU+ country
third-country nationals who have a short-term visa issued by the Czech Republic before 11th May 2020 or short-term or long-term visa issued by other EU+ country
it is possible to enter the country only for the reasons listed in the Ministry of Health (MoH) Protective Measure



Travellers from all countries have an obligation to fill in the Passenger Locator Form before the arrival.



There are several exceptions from the obligation to fill in the Passenger Locator Form or undergo testing. **All rules and exceptions can be found in the Ministry of Health Protective Measure.**
